MIH visits are currently offered at no cost to eligible patients.



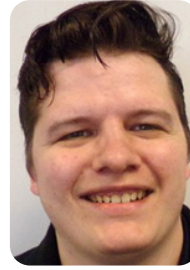
Our Team

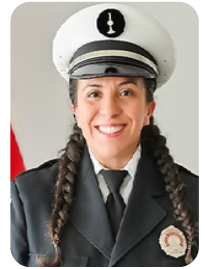

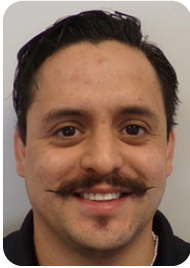

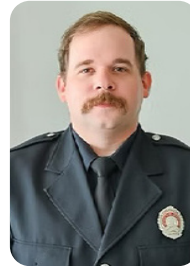
